

## A CHORUS LINE



At midnight on January 8th, 1974 Michael Bennett (who had already choreographed Promises, Promises, Coco, Company, and Follies,) met with twenty-five Broadway "gypsies" and a tape recorder in a dance studio in Manhattan. What happened over the next thirty hours in two all-night sessions became the basis for A Chorus Line. Said Bennett: "What happened was amazing. It had been years since they had thought about their childhood and how they had become dancers. Everyone was getting these triggered memories and they were all talking to me. I said this is like an audition, the strangest kind of audition..." At the time Bennett didn't really know what he would do with all this dancer verite material he had gathered, but over the next 18 months he and his collaborators, supported by Joseph Papp's Public Theatre, crafted in workshop what would become the longest running musical on Broadway.

The world has changed in many ways since 1974, including the advent of AIDS, which took the life of Michael Bennett in 1987. Yet A Chorus Line continues to speak to audiences around the world in unapologetically honest terms of life, growth and risk. The characters Bennett brought to the stage touch us in the audience not because of our own struggling dance careers(!), but because we are all engaged in that basic human endeavor of striving for that which we desire, of putting ourselves on the line for *something* worth the risk of failure. Their struggle is ours, as is their triumph.
