**I**wish: the basis of all fairy tales. It's also the quest which gives our own lives structure and direction (and the basis of good acting: What's my objective? What do I want!). The folks on stage simply trying to get what they want get mired in layers of complexity and confusion before they are allowed to emerge from the woods with new knowledge. As the jumble of simple stories progresses, the characters must go places and do things they would have found inconceivable before their quests, but that's the nature of the woods...

"If you know what you need then you go and you find it and you take it..." Well, yes, but what if someone else's needs are in conflict with yours? And isn't that often the case? This is a fairy tale world devoid of simple answers...(sorry). In act two, particularly, they (and we) are forced to ask if the goal is worth the sacrifice, and clear cut boundaries of good and bad dissolve in the messy realm of reality. What happens after happily ever after?

The pleasure and frustration of working on a piece as demanding as this has given us all a new (or renewed) appreciation of Mr. Sondheim's skills as lyricist and composer. In spite of his detractors, we all know there is plenty to hum in this show, and hope you'll agree...

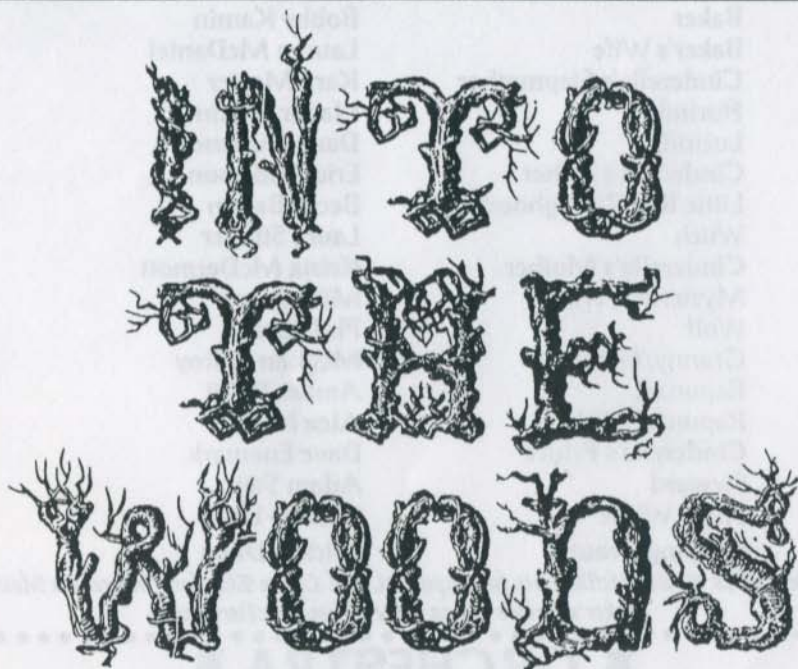
