The Play

Max Reinhardt, the most famous stage director of his generation, did

come to Hollywood from Austria as a refugee from the Nazis, and he directed his first (and only) motion picture, "A Midsummer Night's Dream" for Warner Brothers Pictures in 1934. Jack Warner did have three brothers, Harry, Albert and Sam, who ran the studio with him. And Louella Parsons, the most famous gossip columnist of her day, was born Louella Oettinger in Dixon, Illinois. Dick Powell, who played Lysander in the movie, was indeed a heartthrob of the 1930s. James Cagney, the biggest star of the movie, did play Bottom, though he was best known at the time for gangster pictures. Mickey Rooney, ultimately played Puck in the movie; however, his filming was indeed delayed by the accident he had while skiing with his mother. Also, as Olivia mentions in the course of the play, for 250 years prior 1900, Puck was often played by a woman. The terms of the Production Code that Hays outlines in the play are virtually verbatim from the actual Production Code that caused untold misery for every studio in Hollywood. Moreover, the objections that Hays raises in the play are the ones that the Hays Office actually raised at the time of filming. Objections were withdrawn and no one knows exactly why.
