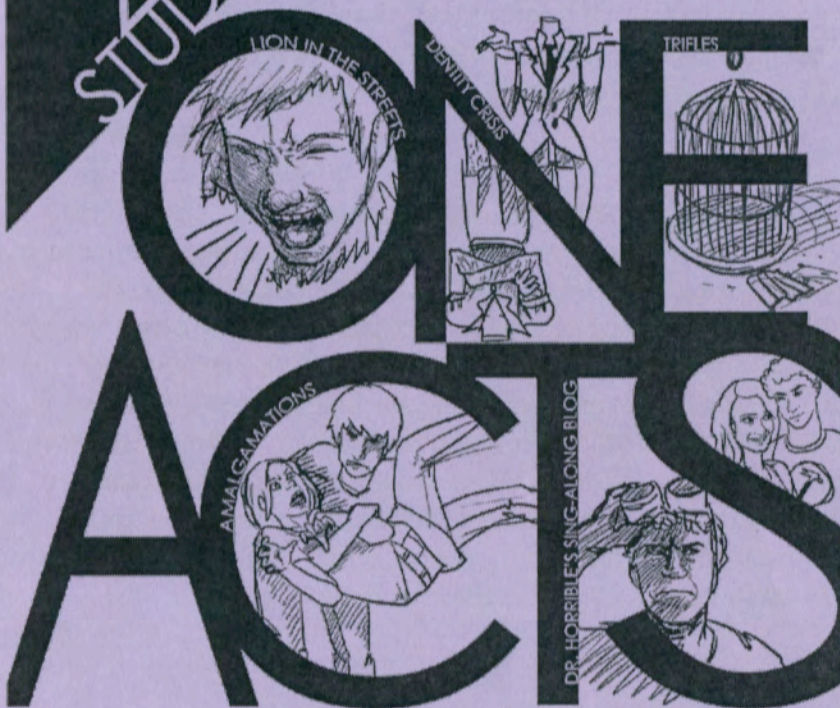

Lion in the Streets by Judith Thompson is an insight into the dark, horrific, emotional, and very private experiences of 8 people.
